CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM LEEVER, RALPH HIBBS, JAMES PARSONS
1860 HIDDEN VILLAGE PLACE
MEDFORD, OR 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of JACKSON CREEK, a tributary of
ROGUE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 36763. The date of priority is
APRIL 25, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation,
measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.; 220
FEET NORTH AND 2376 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 24.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is
as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)
SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to
beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed
herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to
satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream
flows.
