## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for NURSERY OPERATIONS ON 4.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-798. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND NOT TO EXCEED 10.0 ACRE FEET PER YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The use of water under this right may be made at any time of the year.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; EAST 600 FEET FROM NE CORNER OF JOHNSON DLC 55.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.6 ACRES
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 10, 1992, and together with Certificate 67056, supersedes Certificate 28972, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
