CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUBLE M RANCH, INC.
P.O. BOX 38
ADAMS, OREGON 97810

confirms the right to use the waters of RALEY POND, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 26.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42204. The date of priority is MAY 5, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T 4 N, R 28 E, W.M.; 1460 FEET NORTH AND 1840 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ 3.9 ACRES
NE¼ SE¼ 5.4 ACRES
NW¼ SE¼ 6.3 ACRES
SW¼ SE¼ 10.9 ACRES

SECTION 34

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to correct scrivener's errors in the certificate recorded at page 79539, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and supersedes Certificate 79539

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 58969, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 26, 2002, and recorded at Special Order Volume 56, Page 566; approving Transfer Application 8865.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
