CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

IVAN M. GUBSER ROUTE 1, BOX 217 DAYTON, OREGON 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of LAMBERT SLOUGH, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 87.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 41802. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.10 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (NE¼ SW¼), SECTION 3, T 5 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2140 FEET NORTH AND 1550 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 6 (SW¼ NW¼) 2.5 ACRES LOT 6 (SE¼ NW¼) 1.6 ACRES LOT 7 (NE¼ SW¼) 4.0 ACRES LOT 7 (NW¼ SW¼) 10.3 ACRES NW¼ SW¼ 28.0 ACRES SW¼ SW¼ 3.6 ACRES SECTION 3
