CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NESSLEY DITCH COMPANY LAGRANDE, OREGON 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 221.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 36.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 1.

The point of diversion is located in the SW½ SE½, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, W.M.; NESSLEY DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
