CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LOST RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 225.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11431. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1991. This right is limited to 2.81 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.; 45 FEET SOUTH AND 2394 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	39.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	26.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	18.4 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	38.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	38.9 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	31.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	33.1 ACRES

SECTION 11

TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.


The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provision of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
