CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LANCE AND CARRIE BROWN

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8841. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 13, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.; NORTH 3 DEGREES 23 MINUTES 55 SECONDS WEST 957.93 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF THE SE 1/4 SW 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	11.7 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	4.3 ACRES
SECTION 21	
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.	

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 30, 2001, and together with Certificate 80530 AND 80436, supersedes Certificate 52617, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
