 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANDREW & JEANETTE EDER  
 12730 MILLER RD NE  
 GERVAIS, OR 97026

confirms the right to use the waters of PUDDING RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 26.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 16614. The date of priority is October 1, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or the equivalent for each acre irrigated, and a total diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010(6), this certificate confirms the water right for an uncompleted addition of a point of diversion under Transfer Application T-8427 approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 26, 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, at page 157.


This certificate also confirms the right modified by provisions of an order recorded in Special Order Volume 60, at Page 279, canceling and diminishing a portion of the right evidenced by Certificate 16932, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 16932.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
