CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LARRY PETERSON 16877 65TH AVENUE LAKE OSWEGO, OREGON 97035

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SQUAW CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES AND POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4841. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND(CFS); BEING 0.063 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.037 CFS NOT TO EXCEED 9.0 ACRE-FEET EACH YEAR FOR POND MAINTENANCE (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 290 FEET SOUTH AND 140 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 14), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.; 1290 FEET NORTH AND 1100 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE, PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 13, 2001, and supersedes a portion of Certificate 57115, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
