CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID AND REBECCA CAMPBELL
P.O. BOX 167
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL AND BRUSH CREEK,
tributaries of SILVER CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 24.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26167. The date of priority is
MAY 15, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation,
measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

WELL - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION 33,
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 1120 FEET NORTH AND 360
FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33; AND

BRUSH CREEK - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 45, SECTION
33, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited
to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its
equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant
is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 24.2 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN COX DLC 45
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is
subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for
judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of
the date of service.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 26, 1997, and supersedes Certificate 29420, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

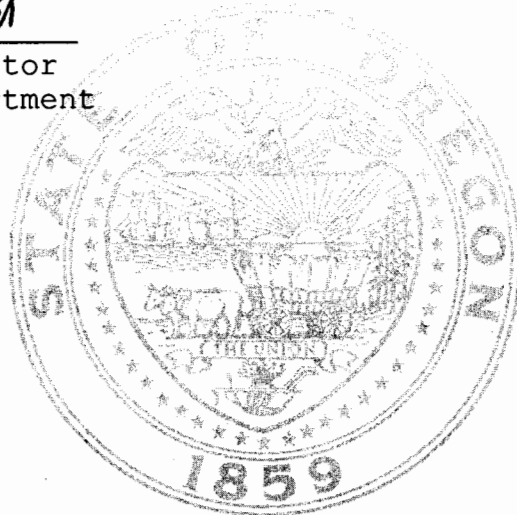
The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
