CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the YAMHILL RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 20.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11416. The date of priority is MAY 16, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 11.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 870 FEET NORTH AND 750 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.8 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 9.6 ACRES
SECTION 4
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 5.8 ACRES
SECTION 5


TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
