CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of PUDDING RIVER, a tributary of MOLALLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 37.0 ACRES.

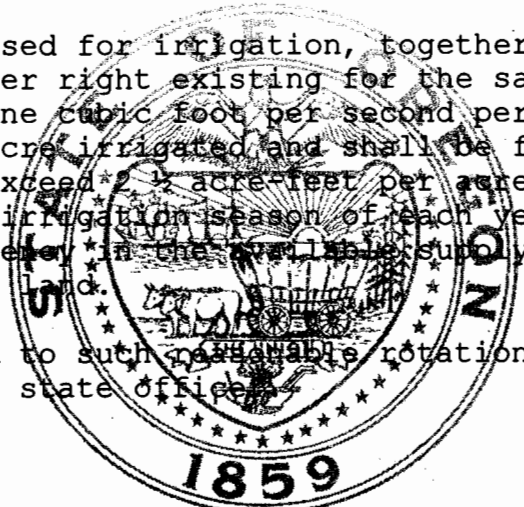
This right was perfected under Permit 46779. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.46 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49, SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 1160 FEET SOUTH AND 1850 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state office.



This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	6.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	2.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	14.6 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	13.7 ACRES

SECTION 7

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
