CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 49.58 ACRES.

This right was perfected under a portion of Permit 53080. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 6 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 550 FEET NORTH AND 1640 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14; AND

LOT 8 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 160 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The period of use allowed under this right is March 1 through October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. However, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

This certificate is issued to confirm perfection of a portion of Permit No. 53080 and does not affect the remaining portion of the permit which is subject to an extension request and perfection by Sonja Lindbloom or successor in interest, as ordered by Judgment of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Douglas County Case No. 00 CV 3207 CC.
