## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

N. H. AND J. L. WEAVER DAYVILLE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIDGE CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 17681. The date of priority is April 17, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> and thereafter ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre irrigated during any month prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 21177, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 16, 2003, and recorded in Special Order Volume 58, Page 264, canceling a portion of the water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
