## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SWANSON GROUP P.O. BOX 459 NOTI, OR 97461

confirms the right to use the waters of DUFFY CREEK, a tributary of BEAVER CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 27790. The date of priority is January 10, 1962. This right is limited to 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or the equivalent, and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
