CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 125.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8841. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 13, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.56 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 31.3 ACRES

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 031 3 ACRES SW 1/4 NW 31.1 ACRES

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 31.3 ACRES

SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

This certificate correctly describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52617, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of Orders of the Water Resources Director entered May 30, 2001, approving transfer Application No. T-8464 and November 14, 2001, approving transfer Application No. T-8713 and supersedes Certificates 76943 and 78330, State Récord of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
