CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WM. E. WEST
71990 EIGHT MILE CANYON ROAD
ARLINGTON, OREGON 97812

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the UMATILLA BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 60.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9911. The date of priority is AUGUST 6, 1982. This right is limited to 0.75 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 22 EAST, W.M.; 1237.5 FEET SOUTH AND 1897.5 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	1.6 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	9.9 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	1.9 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	4.6 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	9.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	11.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	21.2 ACRES

SECTION 8


TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 22 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
