confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 0.29 ACRE.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 498. The date of priority 1885.

The right is limited to not more than 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; MEASURED AT THE DITCH OR THE POINT WHERE THE SAME LEAVES THE NATURAL STREAM, FROM APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 1125 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 35.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.29 ACRE (TRACT A)

SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 20, 1983, and together with Certificate 75430 AND SPECIAL ORDER OF THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR RECORDED in VOLUME 51, PAGE 1387 APPROVING TRANSFER APPLICATION NO. T-7663, supersedes Certificate 46674, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
