CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SALLY H. REYHER
6663 RIPPLING BROOK DRIVE SE
SALEM, OREGON 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7712, a tributary of LITTLE PUDDING RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 0.8 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 43609. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 12, 1978. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49, SECTION 3, T 8 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 95 FEET SOUTH AND 895 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from direct flow and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.1 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 19, 1989, and supersedes Certificate 55531, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
