CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOIS M. CLOUGH  
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ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 4312. The date of priority is OCTOBER 28, 1919. This right is limited to 0.125 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; SOUTH 71 DEGREES WEST, 1220 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 37), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 850 FEET NORTH AND 220 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 7.5 ACRES  
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.5 ACRES  
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47  
SECTION 21  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled; and


The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 27, 1987, and together with Certificate 80544, supersedes Certificate 5390, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
