CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MRS. J. O. METZ
CANYONVILLE, OREGON 97417

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 7666. The date of priority is November 16, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.065 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 24474, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 15, 1987, approving Transfer Application T-5913.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

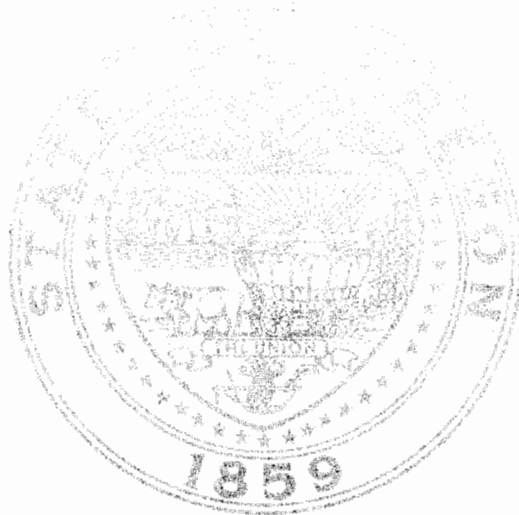
