CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUGLAS COUNTY FOREST PRODUCTS

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for INDUSTRIAL USE.


This right was perfected under Permit 20855. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.446 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 19 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 260 FEET NORTH AND 725 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 19, 2002, and together with Certificate 79738, supersedes Certificate 22281, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
