CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANTONE SCHLECHTER AND MARY SCHLECHTER
11900 MILLER ROAD NE
GERVAIS, OREGON 97026

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 14.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 7.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10415. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1984. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 360 FEET NORTH AND 2480 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 65248, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 24 2004, approving Transfer Application 7143.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
