confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 5 in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4027. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND NOT TO EXCEED 98.4 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION DESCRIBED AS WELL NO. 3 LOCATED WITHIN THE NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.; 2480 FEET NORTH AND 2680 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 22), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

WELL NO. 5 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.; 730 FEET SOUTH AND 150 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The water user shall install an in-time flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
