## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DELAMARTER RANCHES LTD. (OREGON RANCHING COMPANY) 14711 PAULINA HIGHWAY POST OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAVER CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for irrigation of 11.2 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 12966. The date of priority is February 23, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE1/4 NE1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 22 EAST, W.M., 600 FEET SOUTH AND 150 FEET WEST OF THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE1/4 SE1/4 1.8 ACRES Section 15
