CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

ARGYLE WINERY, INC.

Confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 66.1 ACRES.

This right supercedes Certificate 52400. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source: Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 4, Township 6 South, Range 3 East, W.M.; 850 feet North and 60 feet East from SW Corner Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/178.5 of ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 85.9 ACRE-FEET, and 1.3 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by Special Order Volume 52, Page 40 of the Water Resources Director entered January 23, 1998, and corrected by Special Order Volume 54, Page 415 on June 1, 2000.


This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-001-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The user shall install an in-line flow meter that totalizes volume, or similar device approved by the Director for measuring the amount of water diverted. The water user shall maintain the meter in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter; provided however, where the meter is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
