CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Everett A. & Lorri L. Melton

Sisters OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of a well in the Squaw Creek Basin for irrigation of 12.05 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11250. The date of priority is December 17, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M., 1425 Feet South and 238 Feet East from the NW corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.04 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.73 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	8.98 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	2.30 ACRES

SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79636, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 3, 2004, approving Transfer Application 9522.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
