CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 77.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9555. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.97 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1850 FEET SOUTH AND 1040 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.2 ACRES

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 26.2 ACRES

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 37.8 ACRES

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.5 ACRES

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.9 ACRES

SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

This certificate **correctly** describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76281, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 0 1 2004, approving Transfer Application T-8410. This certificate supersedes Certificate 80495.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
