CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MOOREA WATER WORKS c/o WILLIS JOHNSON 2467 MOOREA DRIVE ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA ROVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50727. The date of priority is MAY 30, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.125 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN INGLES DLC 67, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 2520 FEET SOUTH AND 1180 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

> LOT 14 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) -0.8 ACRE SECTION 25

> > NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.1 ACRE

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.1 ACRES

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.8 ACRE

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.7 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.4 ACRE LOT 4 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 1.6 ACRES SECTION 36 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Diversion screening shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
