CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CORNELL BROTHERS, INC
P.O. BOX 533
CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OREGON 97641

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 32.32 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10925. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T 27 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 1320 feet North and 1320 feet East from the SW corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 32.32 ACRES
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

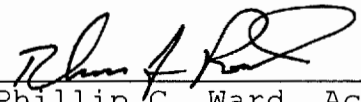
The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. Water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring device, and continue to keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75802, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 14 2004, approving Transfer Application 9375.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
