CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DICKS FORK, a tributary of BIG CREEK, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 36270. The date of priority is JUNE 7, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.4 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.;  
2080 FEET SOUTH AND 1700 FEET WEST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF  
SECTION 8.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
