CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WM. SMITH  
PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 119.5 ACRES, STOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.494 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECT A CLERICAL ERROR IN THE DESCRIPTION THE USE AND PLACE OF USE AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 67249.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
