CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARLENE M. MATSON 281184 MILL CREEK ROAD PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE, STOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING LOCATED WITHIN THE SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.; 1340 FEET SOUTH AND 640 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.5 ACRE SECTION 23 TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department, the water suer shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 25, 1992, and together with Certificate 80665, supersedes Certificates 67249 AND 661, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
