CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Columbia Empire Farms Inc.
(R-2 Ranch)

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of Deschutes River, for IRRIGATION of 29.98 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 57. The date of priority is November 12, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION AT THE CRAM DITCH, LOCATED IN THE NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M., 311 FEET SOUTH and 2913 FEET EAST of the NE CORNER of SECTION 3) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

JOHNSON GALLERY (DIVERSION POINT #3) - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M., 2622 FEET SOUTH and 399 FEET EAST of the NW corner of SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre, including water heretofore appropriated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.23 ACRES

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 24.39 ACRES

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.36 ACRES


TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79648, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 12 2004, approving Transfer Application 9188.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
