## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILLER FORESTS, INC. P.O. BOX 12395 SALEM, OREGON 97309

confirms the right to use the waters of SMALLMAN CREEK, a tributary of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 13.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44036. The date of priority is MARCH 22, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND [IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING LOCATED WITHIN LOT 4 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; 550 FEET SOUTH AND 660 FEET WEST FROM THE WESTERLY NW CORNER OF DLC 53], or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 2 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; 430 FEET SOUTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM THE WESTERLY NW CORERN DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre trigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

> LOT 9 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) LOT 2 (SE 1/4 NB 1/4)

4.7 ACRES 6.8 ACRES

LOT 4 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4)

1.7 ACRES

SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish bypass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 9, 1998 and supersedes Certificate 64518, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
