CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT SALEM, OREGON 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of WOOD CREEK, a tributary of WINDY CREEK, in the UMPQUA BASIN for INSTREAM USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 3871. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1918. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the Wood Creek point of diversion: 1210 feet South and 1010 feet East from the center Corner of Section 22 being within the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 22, Township 32 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The right shall be protected instream during the time period of APRIL 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 1.

A description of the river reach to which this right is appurtenant is as follows: From the Wood Creek point of diversion, 1210 feet South and 1010 feet East from the center Corner of Section 22 being within the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 22, Township 32 South, Range 6 West, W.M. to the confluence with Windy Creek.

This instream right shall replace a portion of any existing instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and be in addition to any instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by Special Order Volume 57, Page 220 of the Water Resources Director entered March 19, 2003.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-001-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.
