CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ALICE P. MILLER WELL NO. 1, a tributary of SPRAGUE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 158.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-350. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1956. This right is limited to 1.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.; 1479 FEET EAST AND 376 FEET NORTH FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 ACRES

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 ACRES

SECTION 3

TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


