CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Baker Creek, for IRRIGATION of 9.3 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-41192. The date of priority is November 1, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE% NW%, Section 16, as projected within DLC 50, T4S, R5W, W.M.; 800 feet South and 1380 feet East from the NW corner of Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
