CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C.F. AND ANNA G. CRONKHITE
BOX 517
CHARLESTON, OREGON 97420

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of SOUTH SLOUGH, for IRRIGATION OF 0.96 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 23237. The date of priority is JULY 22, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.017 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND(CFS), BEING 0.012 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.76 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.20 ACRE

SECTION 2

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
