CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY ROSHAK (ROSHAK LIVING TRUST)

TIGARD, OREGON 97224

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF UP TO ONE-HALF ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit G-488. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 7, 1957. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, NOT TO EXCEED 2.5 ACRE FEET PER YEAR (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION LOCATED WITHIN THE SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; NORTH 63° 54' WEST, 1200.8 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The period of use under this right may be made at any time of the year.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 940 FEET SOUTH AND 103 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE /14
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in, USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 24, 1996, and together with Certificate 73179, supersedes Certificate 30332, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
