CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARION OTTO HUEBNER
10535 AGATE ROAD
EAGLE POINT, OREGON 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 148.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9564. The date of priority is JANUARY 23, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.; 1360 FEET NORTH AND 1220 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	40.0 ACRES
LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)	34.6 ACRES
LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)	34.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	39.4 ACRES

SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE LOCATION OF THE POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 75660.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
