## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRAIG WARREN 194 POISON ROAD WINSTON, OREGON 97496

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST WILLIS CREEK, a tributary of WILLIS CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 0.3 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 39405. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 3, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND(CFS); BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.005 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 430 FEET SOUTH AND 1420 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.3 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
