CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of SIZEMORE SPRINGS tributary of HARNEY LAKE, in RESERVOIRS (RES)1, 2, 3, 4, 5, AND 6, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE WATERING.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-83395. The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and used each year under this right in not more than 8.90 ACRE-FEET (AF), BEING 4.00 AF IN RES 1, 1.20 AF IN RES 2, 1.6 0 EACH ION RES 3 AND 5, 0.10 AF IN RES 4, AND 0.40 AF IN RES 6.



The water right holder may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.


