CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D. O. TRACY LAKEVIEW OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of LA SERE CR, a tributary of DREWS CR for IRRIGATION of 104.15 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Special Order Volume 7, at Page 233. The date of priority is 1884. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.6 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall not exceed three-fourths of an acre-foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half of one acre-foot per acre during any period after June 1st of each year; and 2.5 acre-feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted at a rate not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
