 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARCIA P. COON
 ST. JOHNS, OREGON 97203

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 12.29 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 0.52 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 852. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 20, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.174 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.167 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.007 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 918, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 2, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 60, page 158, approving a petition by Grants Pass Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
