 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WM. H. LAWS
 ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for DOMESTIC, STOCK and IRRIGATION of 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1902.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 32802, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 2, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 60, page 158, approving a petition by Grants Pass Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
