confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31843. The date of priority is AUGUST 11, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
