 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAY STALCUP  
 3172 WOODLAND PARK ROAD  
 GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED DRAINAGEWAY and RESERVOIR constructed under Application No. R-47948 and Permit No. R-5810, a tributary of BAUM SLOUGH (APPLEGATE RIVER), for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 4.84 ACRES and STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 35949. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 11, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second (cfs); being 0.065 cfs for IRRIGATION and 0.01 cfs for STOCK, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

36	S	6	W	W.M.	32	SW	NE	400 FEET NORTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM THE E <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> CORNER OF SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from direct flow, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5810.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 43267, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 2, 2004, and recorded in Special Order Volume 60, page 158, approving a petition by Grants Pass Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
