## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FLOYD F. SHANECK 166 CHINOOK PARK LANE GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 0.4 ACRES AND FROST PROTECTION OF 0.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42220. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 1, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.10 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR FROST PROTECTION, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to this diversion prior to and after the Grants Pass Irrigation District seasonal delivery.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
