CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Wm. Smith
Prineville OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Crooked River, for STOCK USE and IRRIGATION of 97.5 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount actually used beneficially. The right allows use of a reasonable amount for STOCK, and the amount used for IRRIGATION shall not exceed 1.22 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
